## **URBAN CORPS:**

“Corps members attend school two days per week and work in the field three days per week. Through their participation in the program, Corps members receive a paycheck on job training projects such as environmental services, fire fuel reduction, community improvement services, tree planting, habitat restoration, graffiti removal, landscaping, green building construction and recycling. In the process, youth work to earn a high school diploma at our onsite WASC-accredited charter high school offering an accelerated, needs-based, technology-rich academic structure and a low teacher-to-student ratio.” Serves Youth, Ages 18-26.
